

# UOWC PROGRAMS

## NINE ACCREDITED BACHELOR'S DEGREES FOR TOTAL TUITION UNDER \$29,000

This joint effort has two main goals:

- 1.) to provide means for students to obtain an excellent tertiary education completely faithful to the *Magisterium* of the Catholic Church;
- 2.) to do so at a cost accessible to as many students as possible.




The chart below provides brief descriptions of the various programs and how they can relate to nine different bachelor's degrees. As the reader may note, all nine bachelor's degrees offered by the participating institutions may be obtained for tuition totaling under \$29,000 by combining courses from one or more of the participating programs.

If the student completes the *Angelicum Great Books Program* while in high school or homeschooling, the cost drops to about \$16-18,000 *after* those secondary education years (excluding the earlier cost [\$10,200] of the *Angelicum Great Books Program*).

An invaluable "Oxford Experience" at UOWC member St. Bede's Hall, Oxford, U.K. may be added for approximately \$12,600 per semester there.

St Bede’s offers programs of 12-13 weeks. The terms are Michaelmas (Fall), Hilary (Winter) and Trinity (Spring). The dates are from September 29, 2009 to December 20, 2009 for Michaelmas, January 7 to April 11 for Hilary, April 13 to July 11 for Trinity. Students can enroll to take a One-Term, Two-Term or a Full Year program which comprises all three terms. Details of Course Programs indicate what can be covered in one term, unless stated otherwise, but these can be varied, based on students’ preferences and the recommendations of their home universities. The Provost at St Bede’s will recommend to the student’s US college that he/she receive 14-16 US semester credits for the completion of 14 - 18 Oxford tutorials within a thirteen-week period of residence each term. US students normally earn between 14 and 16 semester credits for half an academic year. The term for a student who does academic work at St. Bede’s Hall over a thirteen-week period is therefore approximately equivalent to a standard US semester. Associate Members enrolled for the entire academic year of three terms will normally earn between 36 and 39 US semester credits.

St. Bede’s Hall does not award Bachelor’s Degrees. Credits earned at St. Bede’s must be transferred to a degree granting institution towards a degree there. It offers an “Oxford experience” in Oxford England in a Catholic educational setting.
